

Cadet Winton 2021 - South East Region

The South East region are planning on sending six teams of 4 fencers to Cadet Winton 2021.

The format of the competition is slightly different this year compared to previous years.

The competition is a **U18 team** event this year. All fencers must be **born 2003 or later**.

The competition is **NON-RESIDENTIAL** this year.

Each weapon will be held on a **single day**. Nine regions are expected to be in attendance. The format remains the more traditional (non-ladder) team event.

The individual fencers cost of entry is **£35**.

Venue: Millfield School, Butleigh Road, Street BA16 0YD

FOIL: 18th Dec 2021

EPEE: 19th Dec 2021

SABRE: 20th Dec 2021

Start time to be confirmed.

Interest Date: 21st Nov 2021 (Sunday)

This is the date by which you must indicate an interest in being considered for selection. If you are interested in being considered for selection please send an email to fencingsoutheast@gmail.com stating your fencers name and weapon before this date (21st Nov 2021).

Selection Date: 22nd Nov 2021 (Monday)

This is the date on which the initial selection will be made using the latest published rankings (see below). Notices of selection and how to accept places will go out as soon as possible after this date.

Acceptance Date: 29th Nov 2021 (Monday)

This is the date by which the initial selection must be accepted. After this date if you have not accepted your place it will be offered to others who have indicated an interest in being selected.

Eligible Fencers:

Born 2003 or later

Current British Fencing compete membership with **region set to South East**.

Have indicated an interest in being selected before selection date.

Selection Process

Selections will be made on the selection date from the eligible fencers who have indicated an interest in being selected before the selection date.

In the event of more interest than places in the team. Each team has 4 places. Selection will be made according to rank in:

1. GBR Junior rankings, then

2. GBR Cadet rankings

On the selection day the official rankings used will be the most recently published and timestamped on the British Fencing news page. You can see an example of a timestamped and published rankings on the following page : <https://www.britishfencing.com/junior-mens-epee-18-10-2021-0835/> which was made public on <https://www.britishfencing.com/news/>. No other live or unofficial ranking will be used; just the most recently published and timestamped ranking before the selection date.

If a team remains incomplete after all indications of interest have been exhausted in order of ranking a further public appeal may be made. Selections beyond the initial indications of interest and the ranking process are at the discretion of the South East region committee in consultation with local coaches.
